Our History

The Green Valley Domestic Water Improvement District is a governmental entity organized under Arizona Law which provides for domestic water improvement districts.

The original water company, called Green Valley Water Company, was owned and operated by Fairfield, the developer of the southern part of Green Valley, west of the Interstate 19.

When Fairfield put the company up for sale, the customers were intent on retaining local control of their water future. A group of individuals formed a committee to examine ways to purchase the company.

The District was formed in 2002 by the Pima County Board of Supervisors for the purpose of purchasing and operating what had been the Green Valley Water Company.

A volunteer Board of Directors is elected to four (4) year terms to govern the District. Paid employees include a District Manager, Administrative Supervisor, 2 Customer Service Representatives and 4 Water Operators.

Our Mission

The mission of the District is to supply quality water at adequate volume and pressure to all customers all of the time.

At a minimum, quality water is defined as water that meets and/or exceeds all federal and state standards.

The District is also committed to respond to all service requirements as rapidly as possible, listening to our customers, and responding promptly to all inquiries and reasonable requests.
